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### NOTE

Recently, the Nevada Department of Transportation had a question brought to our attention about when and who should be listed on the one and five percent subcontractor forms in our bid package. The question was, "Should contractors who are not required to be licensed under the provisions of NRS 624 (the Nevada State Contractors Board requirements) be listed on these forms?" NDOT discussed the question with legal counsel and our opinion is that these firms are required to be listed for the following reason. NRS 338.141 specifies that you must name each subcontractor that will provide labor or a portion of the work or improvement on a public work. Further, NRS 338.445 defines a subcontractor as "Subcontractor" means a person who: 1. Is licensed pursuant to the provisions of chapter 624 of NRS or performs such work that he is not required to be licensed pursuant to chapter 624 or NRS; and 2. Contracts with a contractor, another subcontractor or a supplier to provide labor, materials or services for a public work. Applying this definition to the question, we believe that firms that provide services such as traffic control, surveying or any other service that does not require a contractor's license should have be listed as a subcontractor. In the future, any subcontractor that fits this definition should be listed on the one and five percent subcontractor forms. If you have further questions, please call Roc A. **ON STATE FUNDED PROJECTS:**

On State funded projects Contractors and subcontractors are required to hold a valid contractor's license of a class corresponding to the work to be done, in accordance with the provisions of NRS Chapter 624, prior to submitting a bid.

The bidder's attention is directed to the provisions of NRS 338.147 which is summarized as follows: A responsible bidder who at the time of submitting his bid provides a copy of a certificate of eligibility to receive a preference in bidding on public works, issued to him by the State Contractor's Board, shall be deemed to have submitted a better bid than a competing bidder who has not provided a copy of such a valid certificate of eligibility if the amount of his bid is not more than 5% higher than the amount bid by the competing bidder.

**ON FEDERAL AID PROJECTS:**

On Federal-aid projects Contractors, prequalified by the Nevada Department of Transportation, and subcontractors are not required to be licensed in advance of submitting a bid or having such bid considered. Both Contractors and subcontractors shall obtain a valid contractor's license, in accordance with the provisions of NRS Chapter 624, within 20 days after the contract has been awarded. Execution of the contract by the Contractor shall be deemed a certification that the licensing requirements have been met. Contractors and subcontractors are encouraged to submit applications for licensure to the Nevada State Contractor's Board in advance of contract advertisement.

The Contractor agrees to ensure that disadvantaged business enterprises as defined in 49 CRF, Part 26 Amended have the maximum opportunity to participate in the performance of the contracts and subcontracts financed in whole or in part with Federal funds. The requirements for compliance are contained in subsection 102.03 and 103.02 of the Special Provisions and in the contract provisions appended to the Special Provisions.
