**INSTALLING AN AUTOMATIC FIRE SPRINKLER SYSTEM IN BUILDING LOCATED AT 1241 SOUTH OREGON STREET, CONNECTING SYSTEM TO CITY WATER SUPPLY AND TO FIRE MONITORING PANEL AT 1263 SOUTH STEWART STREET, CARSON CITY, NEVADA.**

**Around the Clock Work Pays Off as NDOT Battles "Storm of the Century"**

A series of storms pounded the entire state of Nevada in late December and early January, blanketing mountaintops throughout the state. Precipitation in northern Nevada was so great that buildings collapsed and snowplows were manned to clear highways around the clock. In southern Nevada, Mt. Charleston was hit with several feet of snow and the Muddy River overflowed near Overton.

**Western Nevada:** "We've seen heavier snow, but not a storm that lasted so long," said Larry Hough, supervisor for Crew 271. "We saw three feet in a night."

Ron Millim, supervisor of crew 270, saw something he hadn't seen in 27 years with NDOT: 40 southbound cars stopped by drifting snow in Washoe Valley. Drifts were caused by 50 mph winds blowing the snow horizontally.

"We cut a hole with a snowplow, and then we pulled out or pushed out the cars, and then we escorted them out. Our crew did a good job."

**Eastern and Northern Nevada:** The storm was not as severe in eastern Nevada. "We had a lot of hours," Crew 332 supervisor Buzz Jackson said, and somebody out all the time and we used mag chloride before the storm started and then we were out with the sanders."

Near Emigrant Pass there was a 10-vehicle chain reaction accident on Jan. 18 that included semi trucks. The accident closed the highway for several hours.

**Southern Nevada:** Heavy rains took a much greater toll in southern Nevada when high water took out a big section of SR-317 south of Caliente. In Mesquite, Virgin River flooding damaged a bridge pier and piers were undermined on a bridge on SR-170.

An avalanche struck a ski resort on Mt. Charleston outside of Las Vegas, taking the life of a youngster, and NDOT crews worked to keep up with heavy snowfall.

At the height of the storm, which dumped five feet of snow, a second shift was added and a second snow blower was brought in from Tonopah.

**ON STATE FUNDED PROJECTS:**

On State funded projects the bidder is required to hold a valid contractor's license of a class corresponding to the work to be done prior to submitting a bid in accordance with the provisions of NRS Chapter 624.

The bidder's attention is directed to the provisions of NRS 338.147 which is summarized as follows: A responsible bidder who at the time of submitting his bid provides a copy of a certificate of eligibility to receive a preference in bidding on public works, issued to him by the State Contractor's Board, shall be deemed to have submitted a better bid than a competing bidder who has not provided a copy of such a valid certificate of eligibility if the amount of his bid is not more than 5% higher than the amount bid by the competing bidder.

**ON FEDERAL AID PROJECTS:**

On Federal-aid projects any Contractor, otherwise qualified by the State of Nevada to perform such work, is not required to be licensed nor to submit application for license in advance of submitting a bid or having such bid considered. However, the Contractor determined to be the successful bidder shall obtain the required license in accordance with the provisions of NRS Chapter 624 prior to executing the contract.

The Contractor agrees to ensure that disadvantaged business enterprises as defined in 49 CRF, Part 26 Amended have the maximum opportunity to participate in the performance of the contracts and subcontracts financed in whole or in part with Federal funds. The requirements for compliance are contained in subsection 102.03 and 103.02 of the Special Provisions and in the contract provisions appended to the Special Provisions.
