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Director Tom Stephens joined District II officials in cutting the ribbon on NDOT's new building for Reno Road, the nerve center for winter road conditions and radio communications for much of northern Nevada. The building along came with a complex remodeling of many other facilities at the yard. The remodel relocated the carpenter shop, replaced training facilities and added roofing and drainage improvements. All the new rooms were recabled for data and phone network communications.

Designed by consultant Hershenow and Klippenstein Architects, the new storm center facility was built by F. Evans Construction. With guidance from NDOT Architecture Division's Brett Frey and Marc Davis, district crews 202, 240, 241 and 245 pitched in.

The communications center is staffed 24-hours a day from November to May. The new road condition number is 1 (877) NVROADS, or 1 (877) 687-6237, with an online version at www.nvroads.com or www.nevadadot.com.

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Meeting in Las Vegas for the first time in years, the State Transportation Board entered the year 2000 with Clark County on its mind. Gov. Kenny Guinn asked for the change of venue to highlight a southern Nevada perspective.

The January meeting focused on air quality in the Las Vegas metropolitan area with informational presentations from numerous public agencies that play a role in compliance with Environmental Protection Agency regulations, a requirement for federal transportation funding. It was teleconferenced to gatherings in Carson City and Elko where transportation stakeholders and NDOT staff had gathered to watch.

Gov. Guinn honored NDOT's Jerry Lemming who retired from Las Vegas Construction with 30 years. He also recognized the Las Vegas Materials Lab for recent full accreditation by the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials. Kevin Hill of the Nevada Chapter of the American Public Works Association told the board that NDOT won the group's 1999 Project of the Year award for jobs more than \$1 million for the reconstruction of Reno's Center Street Bridge.

Hosting the meeting was a job in itself. It came off as a partnership between Carson City, Las Vegas and Elko staff who wired, connected, created, copied, displayed, briefed and otherwise coordinated the five-hour meeting.

ON STATE FUNDED PROJECTS:

On State funded projects the bidder is required to hold a valid contractor's license of a class corresponding to the work to be done prior to submitting a bid in accordance with the provisions of NRS Chapter 624.

The bidder's attention is directed to the provisions of NRS 338.147 which is summarized as follows: A responsible bidder who at the time of submitting his bid provides proof of either: (1) payment of at least five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) per year of sales and use tax on materials used for construction for each of the five (5) immediate preceding years or: (2) payment of at least five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) per year of motor vehicle privilege tax for each of the five (5) immediate preceding years, shall be deemed to have submitted a better bid than a competing bidder who has not paid the taxes if the amount of his bid is not more than five (5) percent higher than the amount bid by the competing bidder.

ON FEDERAL AID PROJECTS:

On Federal-aid projects any Contractor, otherwise qualified by the State of Nevada to perform such work, is not required to be licensed nor to submit application for license in advance of submitting a bid or having such bid considered. However, the Contractor determined to be the successful bidder shall obtain the required license in accordance with the provisions of NRS Chapter 624 prior to executing the contract.

The Contractor agrees to ensure that disadvantaged business enterprises as defined in 49 CRF, Part 23 Amended have the maximum opportunity to participate in the performance of the contracts and subcontracts financed in whole or in part with Federal funds. The requirements for compliance are contained in subsection 102.03 and 103.02 of the Special Provisions and in the contract provisions appended to the Special Provisions.
