SPECIFIC DESCRIPTION OF WORK COVERED BY THIS CONTRACT CONSISTS OF: **A) CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW 2,493 SQUARE FOOT CLUBHOUSE FACILITY, CONSISTING OF SLAB-ON-GRADE, 2 x 6 WOOD FRAME CONSTRUCTION, PREFABRICATED WOOD TRUSSES, FIBERGLASS COMPOSITION SHINGLE ROOF; B) NEW SWIMMING POOL AND ENCLOSURE; C) SITE IMPROVEMENTS, INCLUDING GRADING, PAVING, LANDSCAPING AND UTILITIES AND D) PHASED DEMOLITION OF EXISTING FACILITIES, INCLUDING CLUBHOUSE AND ATTACHED MANAGER'S RESIDENCE, SWIMMING POOL AND OTHER SITE IMPROVEMENTS.** The Engineer's estimate on this project for is **\$875,608.00**.

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An anonymous donor with a conscience sent a \$5 money order to NDOT to cover the cost of a highway sign stolen years ago in Ely.

ON STATE FUNDED PROJECTS:

On State funded projects the bidder is required to hold a valid contractor's license of a class corresponding to the work to be done prior to submitting a bid in accordance with the provisions of NRS Chapter 624.

The bidder's attention is directed to the provisions of NRS 338.147 which is summarized as follows: A responsible bidder who at the time of submitting his bid provides proof of either: (1) payment of at least five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) per year of sales and use tax on materials used for construction for each of the five (5) immediate preceding years or: (2) payment of at least five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) per year of motor vehicle privilege tax for each of the five (5) immediate preceding years, shall be deemed to have submitted a better bid than a competing bidder who has not paid the taxes if the amount of his bid is not more than five (5) percent higher than the amount bid by the competing bidder.

ON FEDERAL AID PROJECTS:

On Federal-aid projects any Contractor, otherwise qualified by the State of Nevada to perform such work, is not required to be licensed nor to submit application for license in advance of submitting a bid or having such bid considered. However, the Contractor determined to be the successful bidder shall obtain the required license in accordance with the provisions of NRS Chapter 624 prior to executing the contract.

The Contractor agrees to ensure that disadvantaged business enterprises as defined in 49 CRF, Part 23 Amended have the maximum opportunity to participate in the performance of the contracts and subcontracts financed in whole or in part with Federal funds. The requirements for compliance are contained in subsection 102.03 and 103.02 of the Special Provisions and in the contract provisions appended to the Special Provisions.
