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A project to revitalize Crystal Bay, a gateway community in serious need of aesthetic improvement, won the 1999 Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Annual Building and Erosion Control Award for Beautification. ON STATE FUNDED PROJECTS:

On State funded projects the bidder is required to hold a valid contractor's license of a class corresponding to the work to be done prior to submitting a bid in accordance with the provisions of NRS Chapter 624.

The bidder's attention is directed to the provisions of NRS 338.147 which is summarized as follows: A responsible bidder who at the time of submitting his bid provides proof of either: (1) payment of at least five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) per year of sales and use tax on materials used for construction for each of the five (5) immediate preceding years or: (2) payment of at least five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) per year of motor vehicle privilege tax for each of the five (5) immediate preceding years, shall be deemed to have submitted a better bid than a competing bidder who has not paid the taxes if the amount of his bid is not more than five (5) percent higher than the amount bid by the competing bidder.

ON FEDERAL AID PROJECTS:

On Federal-aid projects any Contractor, otherwise qualified by the State of Nevada to perform such work, is not required to be licensed nor to submit application for license in advance of submitting a bid or having such bid considered. However, the Contractor determined to be the successful bidder shall obtain the required license in accordance with the provisions of NRS Chapter 624 prior to executing the contract.

The Contractor agrees to ensure that disadvantaged business enterprises as defined in 49 CRF, Part 23 Amended have the maximum opportunity to participate in the performance of the contracts and subcontracts financed in whole or in part with Federal funds. The requirements for

compliance are contained in subsection 102.03 and 103.02 of the Special Provisions and in the contract provisions appended to the Special Provisions.
