Reference is made to the Request for Proposal to Consultants for Airport System Manager Program for the Nevada Airport System Plan, upon which proposals will be received until 3:00 p.m., local time, on **Monday, November 30, 2009**.

Question 1:

Please clarify paragraph "8. Products" on page 7 of the RFP. It doesn't seem to pertain to this project.

Answer 1:

This project is the continuation of a system planning effort that began over a decade ago to improve aviation throughout Nevada and will greatly enhance the capabilities of Nevada to aid the FAA and the individual airports in maintaining pertinent data on existing facilities, planning for future facilities and monitoring the development of ongoing improvements projects.

All efforts in this project relate to giving the FAA, the State, and local airport sponsors useful tools to help manage planning and/or programming funds. The implementation of ASM modules with a web-based architecture will allow a greater partnership in airport planning for Nevada. Both FAA and State emphasis is placed on better planning and more efficient time management of personnel and resources to insure a safe, efficient system of airports is developed. This project will accomplish an improved continuation of planning efforts and will serve as a model for states around the nation. The FAA is funding this project and requires a report of the project for what they paid for.

The Public Portal (NEVADA public website) portion of the program pulls together a variety of facility and flight information tailored towards the statewide system of airports and communicates it to the general public by making it available over the Internet.

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
