

NDOT OVER DIMENSIONAL VEHICLE PERMITS LETTER OF INSTRUCTION 5-10

Date: January 4, 2010

Subject: Prohibited Routes for Overweight Vehicles during Spring Thaw

1. **Purpose.** To prohibit vehicles and loads exceeding legal single, tandem and tridem axle weights from traveling on specific routes under the jurisdiction of the State of Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT).
2. **Background.** Due to possible severe pavement damage during spring thaw conditions, specific routes are prohibited pursuant to reference (a). Overweight fines double on the prohibited routes pursuant to references (b) and (c). These prohibitions are updated as required and are not all-inclusive. Additional permanent and temporary restrictions/prohibitions may be imposed due to other size or weight factors, maintenance, construction or acts of nature and will be advertised on the NDOT web site.
3. **Procedures and Conditions**
 - a. These instructions including the enclosure apply from February 1 through April 30 of every year to all overweight, over-dimensional vehicles (ODVs) requiring annual, single-trip or special permits with Green or Purple Weight, issued by the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT). The routes indicated in the enclosure are restricted to legal single, tandem and tridem axle weight limits during this period.
 - b. Exceptions to these prohibitions will only be considered in extraordinary circumstances when there is no other reasonable alternate route or when the point of origin, destination, pick-up or delivery is on the prohibited route. Standing escort requirements apply to oversized ODVs.
 - c. Permittees may have to obtain additional permits from other agencies for roadways not under the jurisdiction of NDOT.
 - d. Possession of an annual ODV permit does not provide authorization to use any portion of the prohibited routes for any reason.

4. **Action**

- a. Permittees are required to abide by these instructions unless otherwise advised by an authorized NDOT representative or permit agent. In addition to their permit, permittees are advised to carry a copy of the enclosure and other applicable restriction/prohibition lists/maps during all movements.
- b. Permit agents at NDOT will comply with this instruction, maintain a copy for daily reference, and make a copy of the enclosure with map available to all permittees.

5. **Supersedes**. NDOT Over Dimensional Permits Instruction 5-09 dated January 5, 2009.

▪ **February 1st through April 30th of every year**, overweight ODVs, requiring annual, single-trip or special permits with Green or Purple Weight, issued by the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT), are **PROHIBITED** from using the below routes. These routes are restricted to legal single, tandem and tridem axle weight limits during this period. Standing escort requirements apply to oversized ODVs. Overweight fines double on these routes.
