

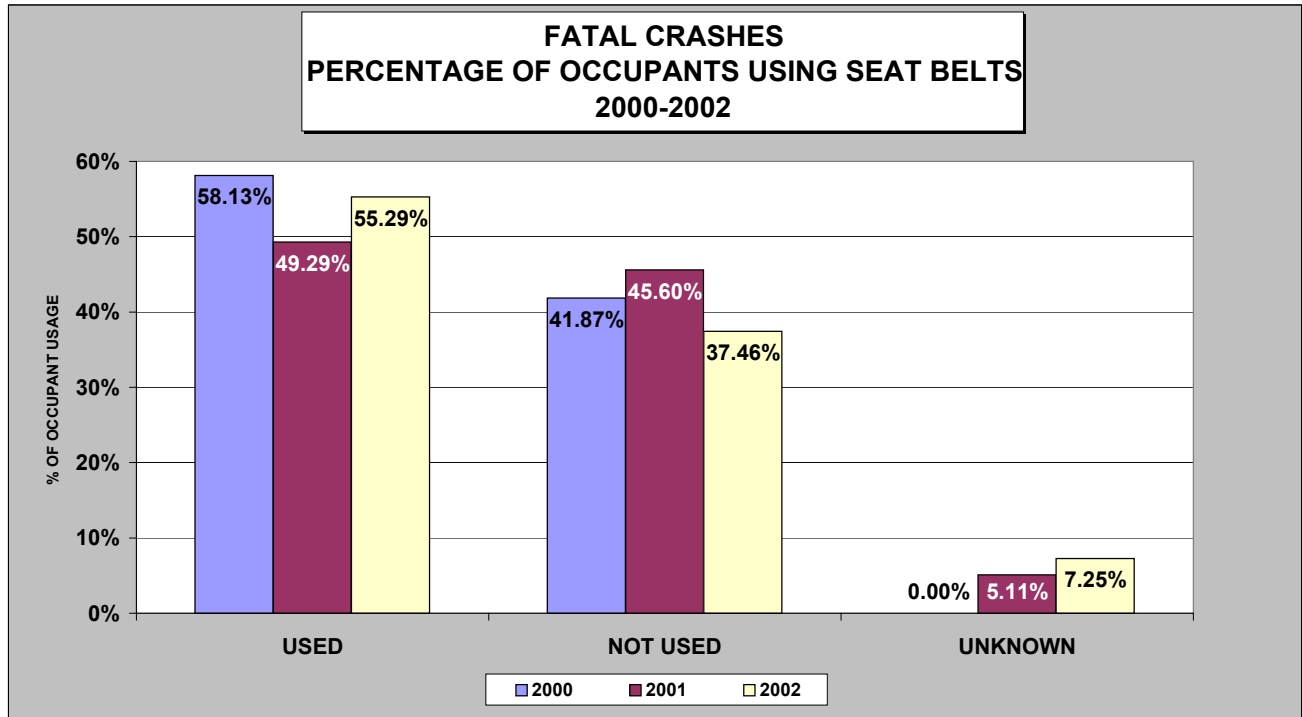


OCCUPANT RESTRAINTS

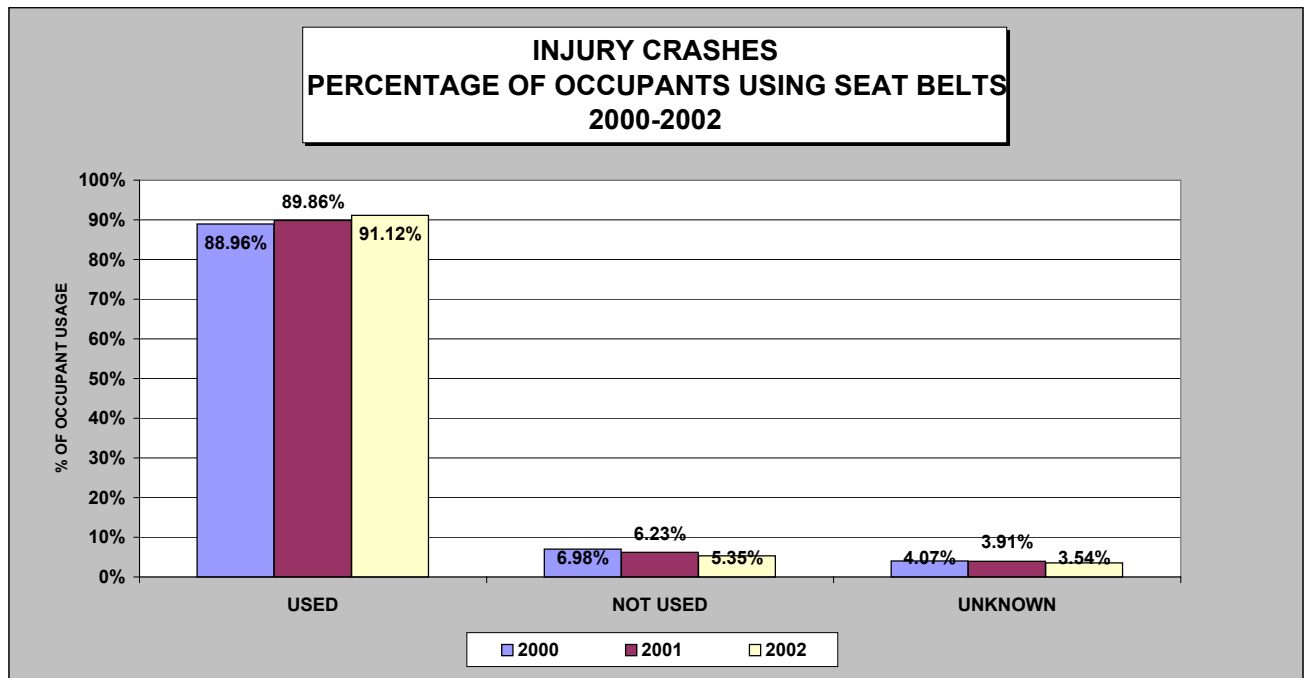
This section presents a series of data displays that identify restraint use for occupants in fatal and injury crashes.

2002 SUMMARY ANALYSIS

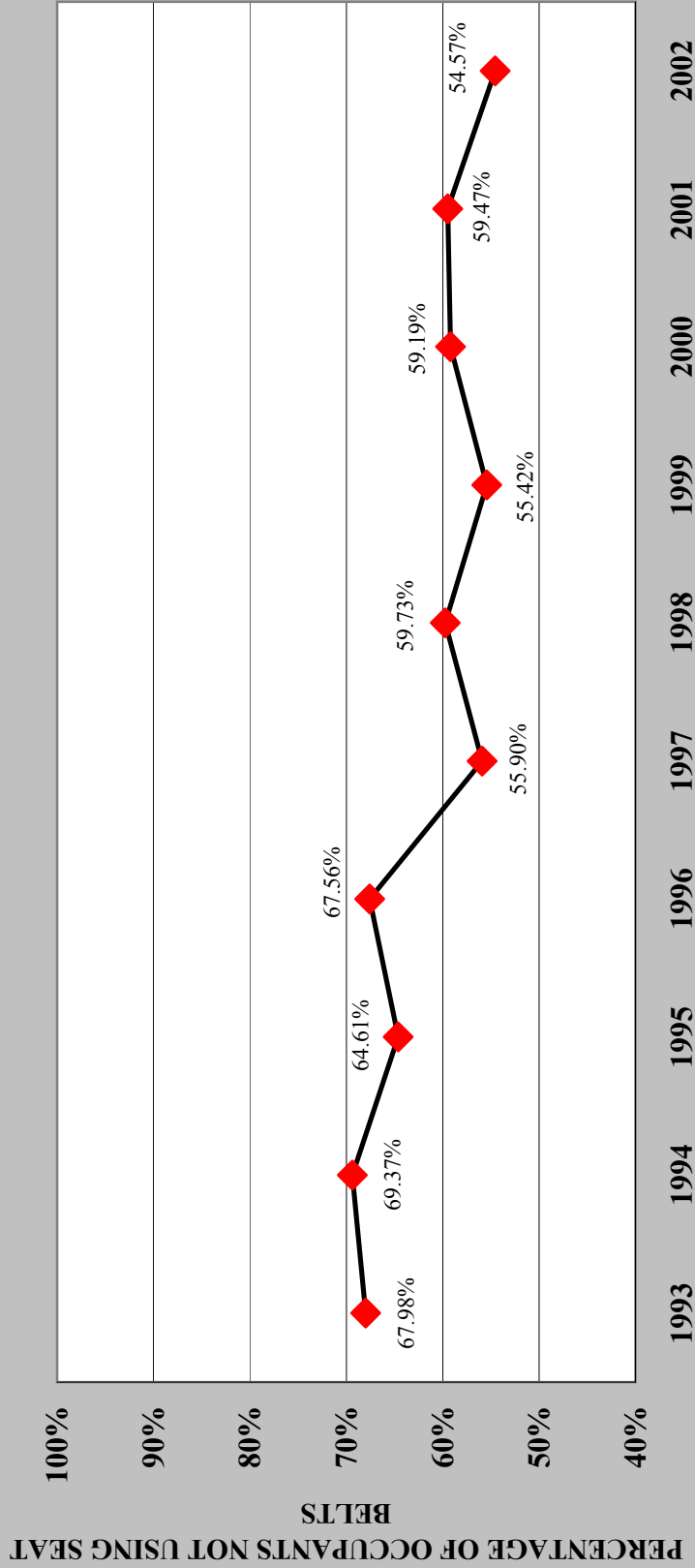
- ◆ The percentage of seat belts used in fatal and injury crashes has increased from 87.17% in 2000 to 89.03% in 2002.
- ◆ Non-use of restraints by victims in fatal crashes has decreased from 59.19% in 2000 to 54.57% in 2002.
