The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) invites you to attend a public information meeting to provide input for the Eastern Ave./Civic Center Dr. Safety Improvement Project. The purpose of this project is to enhance safety on Eastern Ave./Civic Center Dr. between Cope Ave. and US-95 for all road users. NDOT is seeking your input on the proposed design improvements that would increase safety for all road users including:

- Pedestrian safety improvements including widening sidewalks, lighting and pedestrian crossings
- Roadway safety improvements including raised medians and access management to reduce traffic conflict points
- Installation of pedestrian flashing beacons
- Intersection reconfiguration to increase pedestrian and vehicle safety
- Signal improvements and reconfiguration

Please attend at your convenience any time during the hours of 4 to 7 p.m. Project representatives will be on hand to discuss and answer your questions. There will be a brief project presentation at 5:30 p.m. followed by a short comment period from the audience. Before and after the presentation, the meeting will be conducted as an open house format to provide attendees with an opportunity to view displays and individually discuss the project with project representatives. In addition to those received at this meeting, comments will be accepted until 5 p.m. on Friday, February 23, 2018.
