

## REQUEST TO SUBLET

Prior to any subcontractor working on the project, a Request to Sublet (RTS) (NDOT Form 052-023) must be prepared by the prime contractor and /or subcontractor and submitted to the Resident Engineer. The form is available at [www.nevadadbe.com/website/contract-compliance.php](http://www.nevadadbe.com/website/contract-compliance.php). NDOT employees can also access this form on Sharepoint under Civil Rights - External.

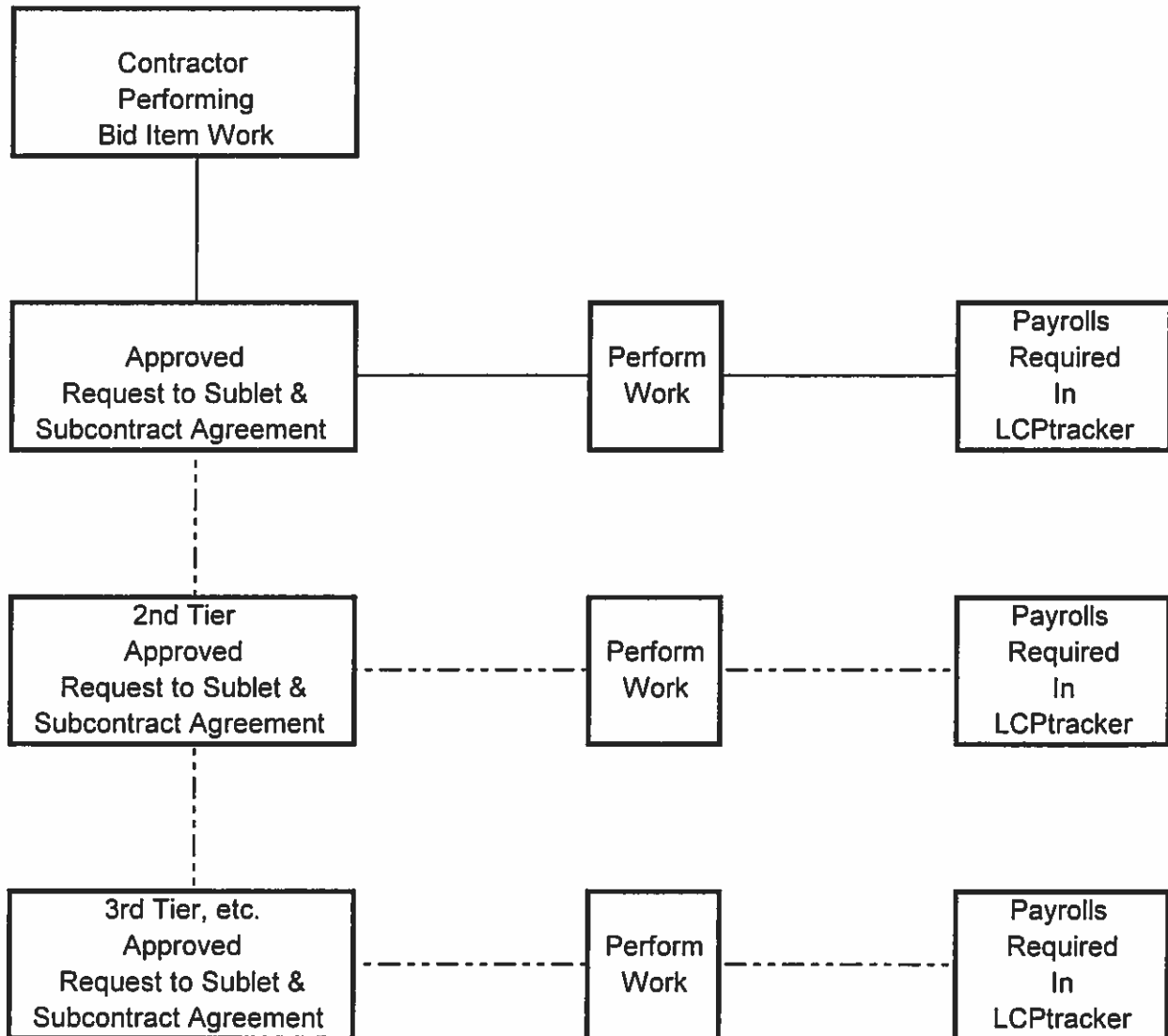

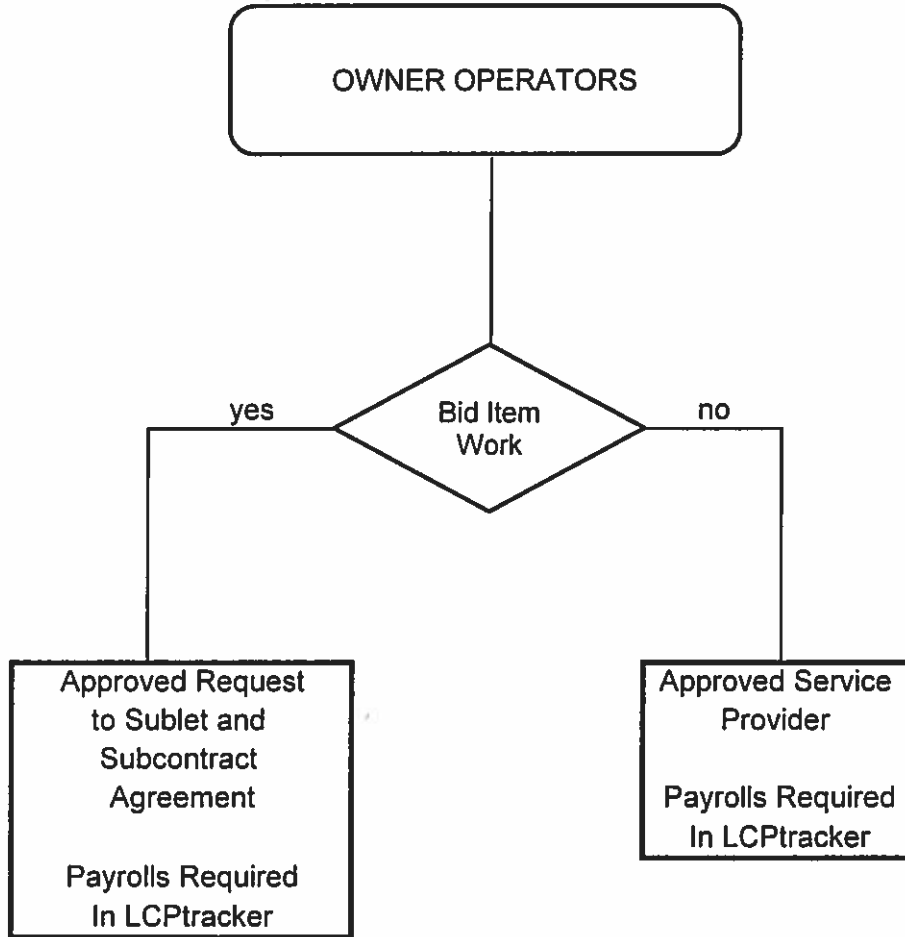
