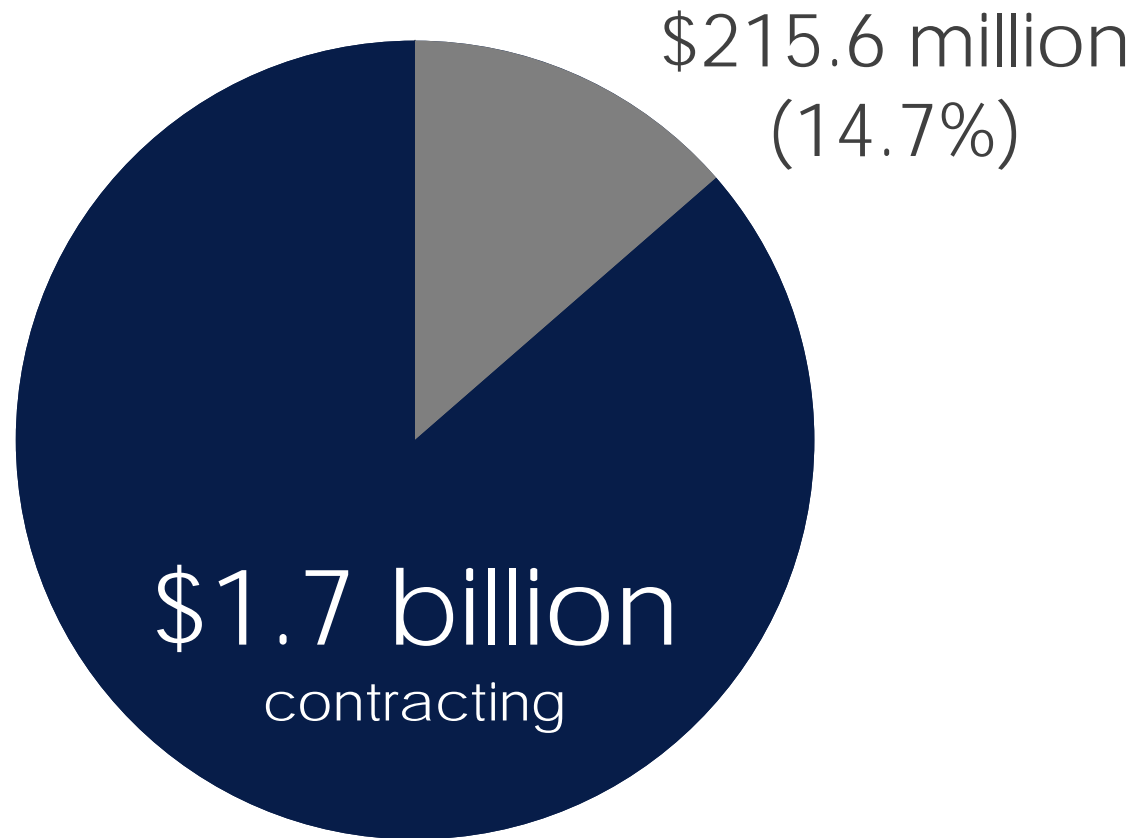

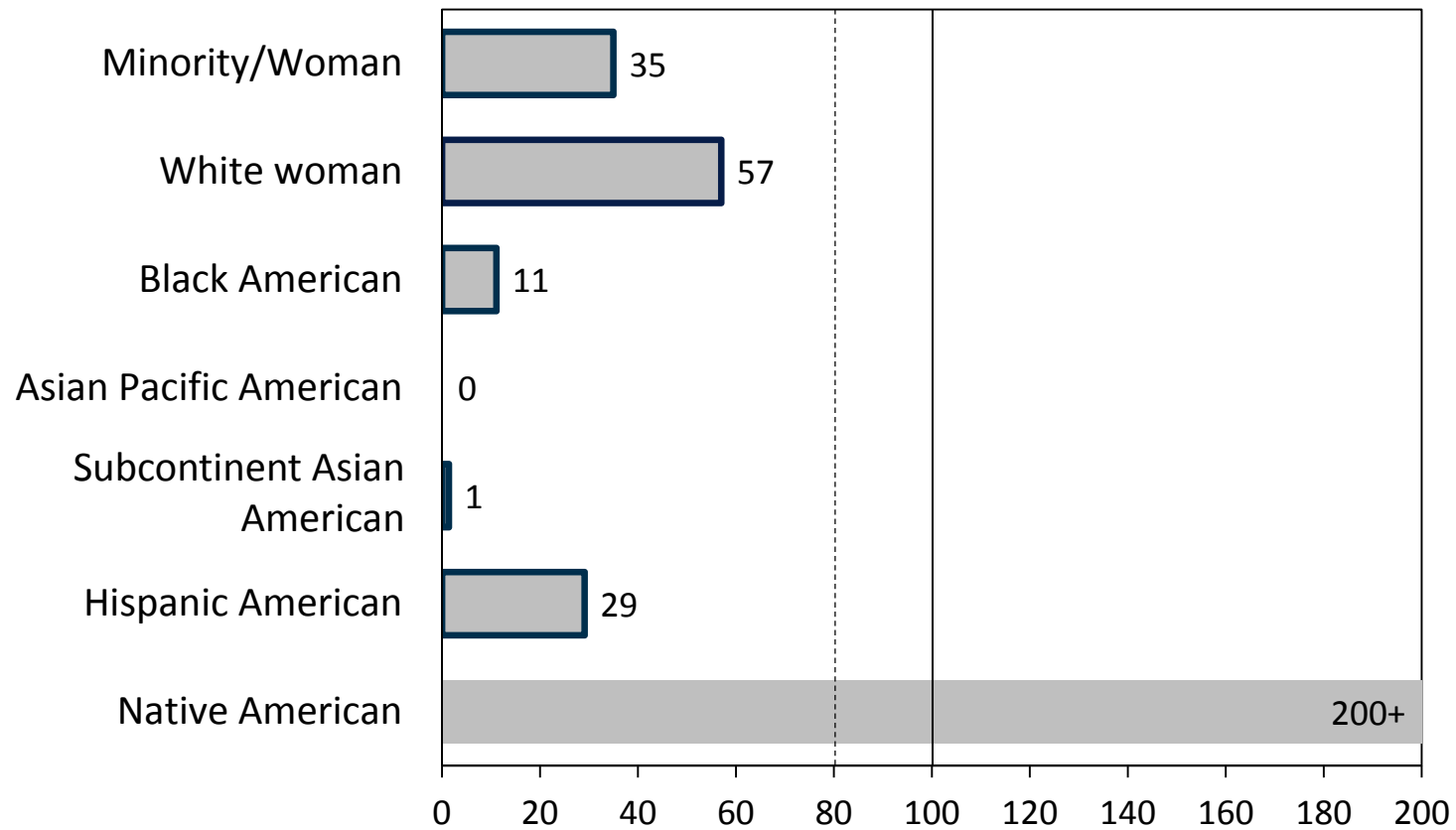

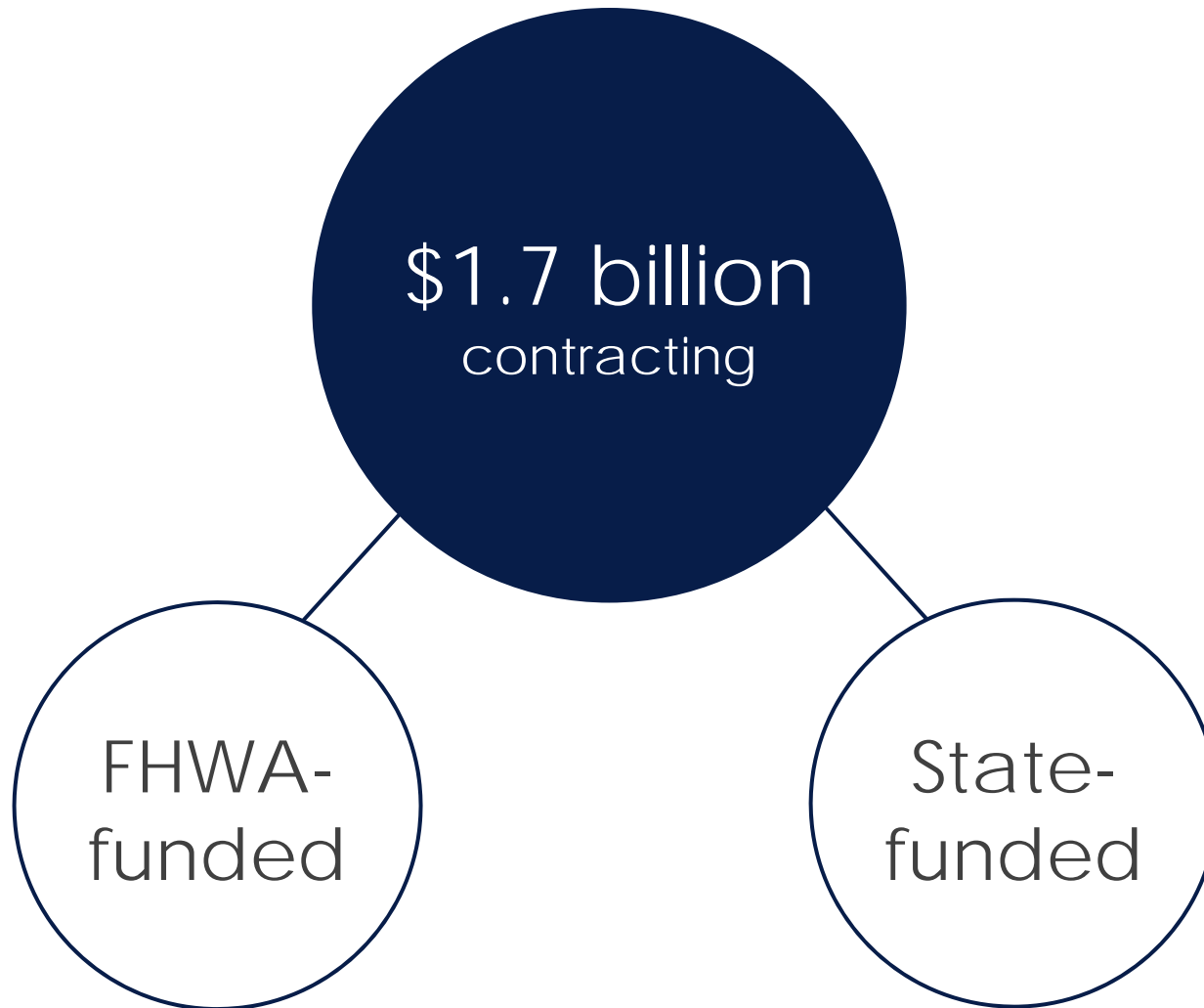
$$\frac{\text{Dollars utilization}}{\text{Dollars available}} = \text{DISPARITY INDEX}$$

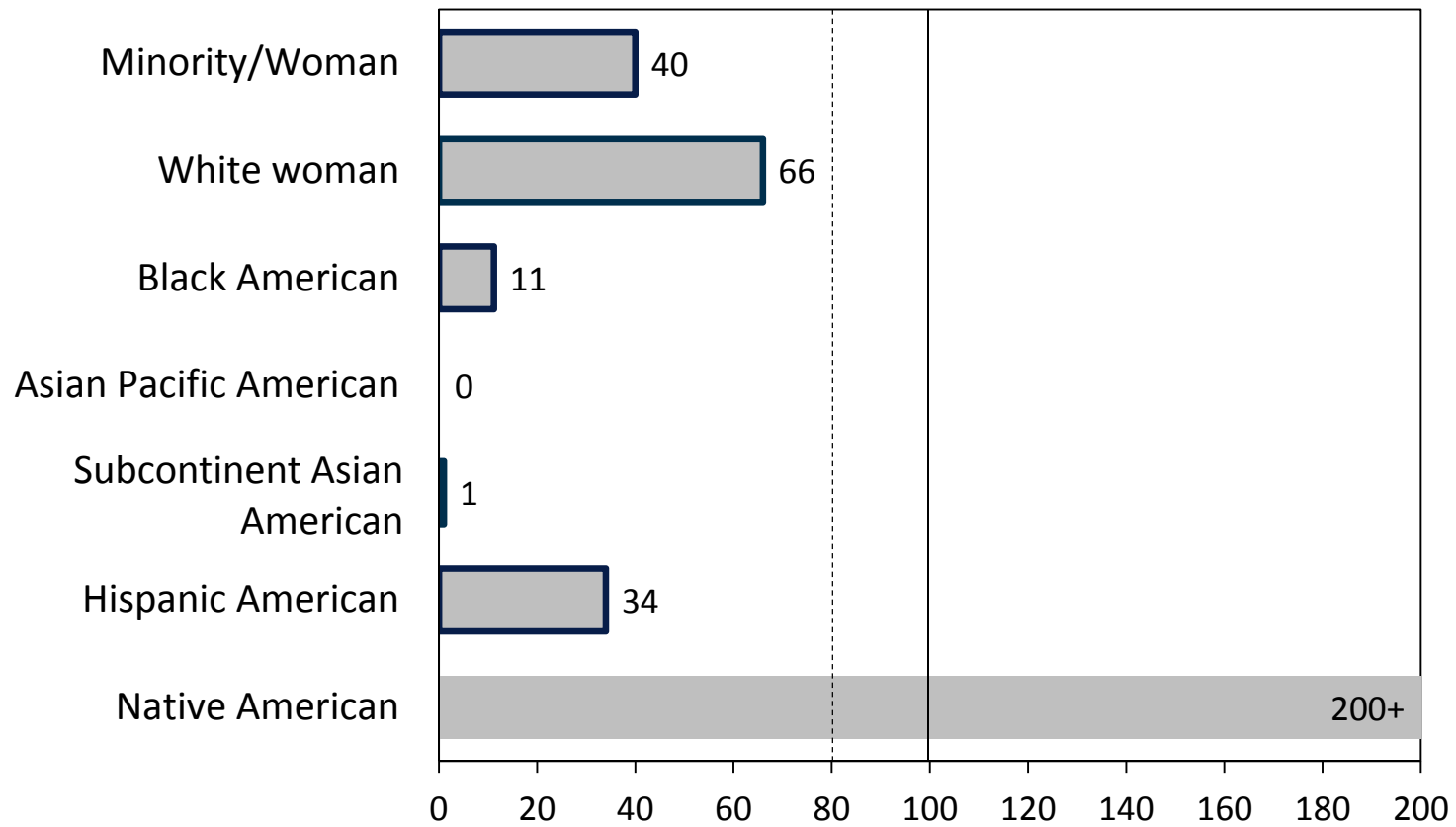

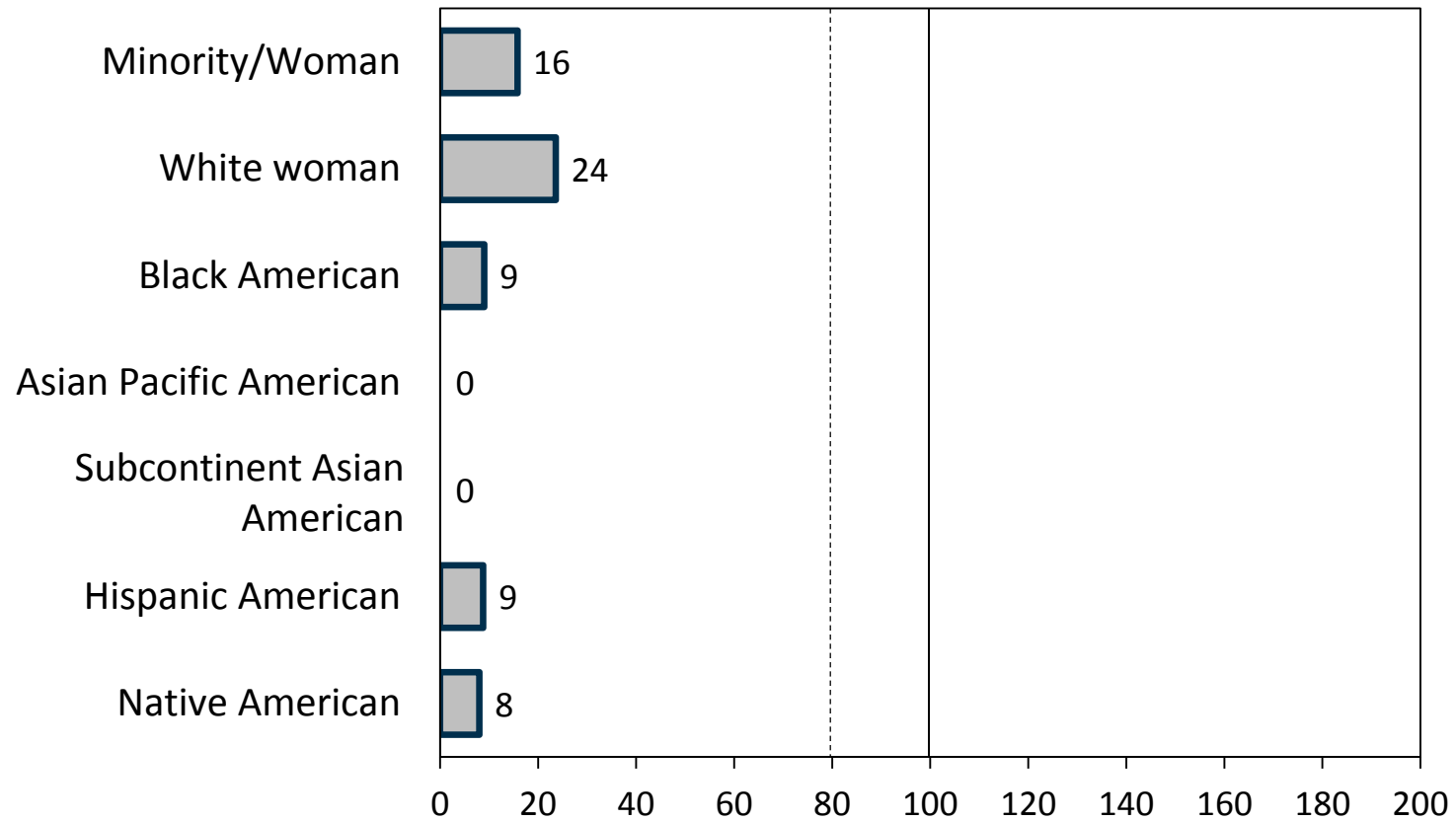
RESULTS - FHWA

FHWA-Funded



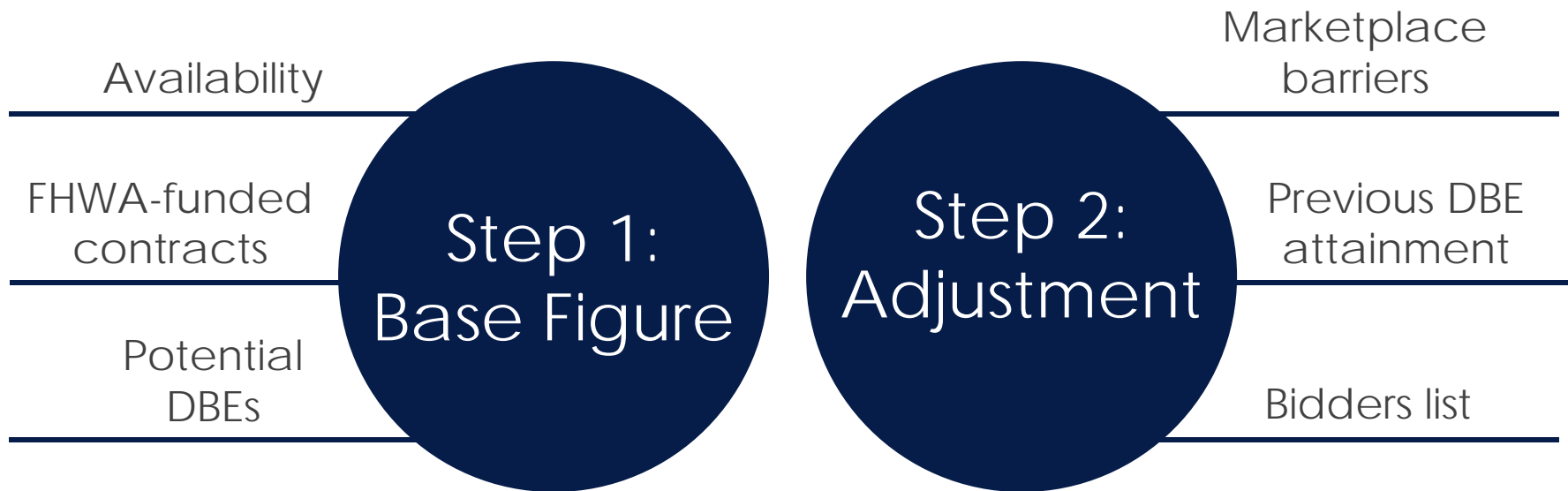

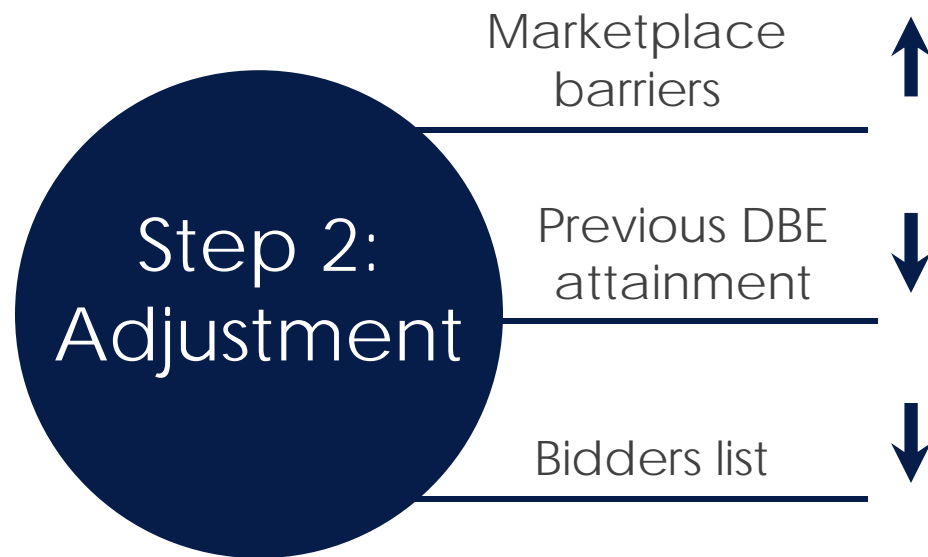

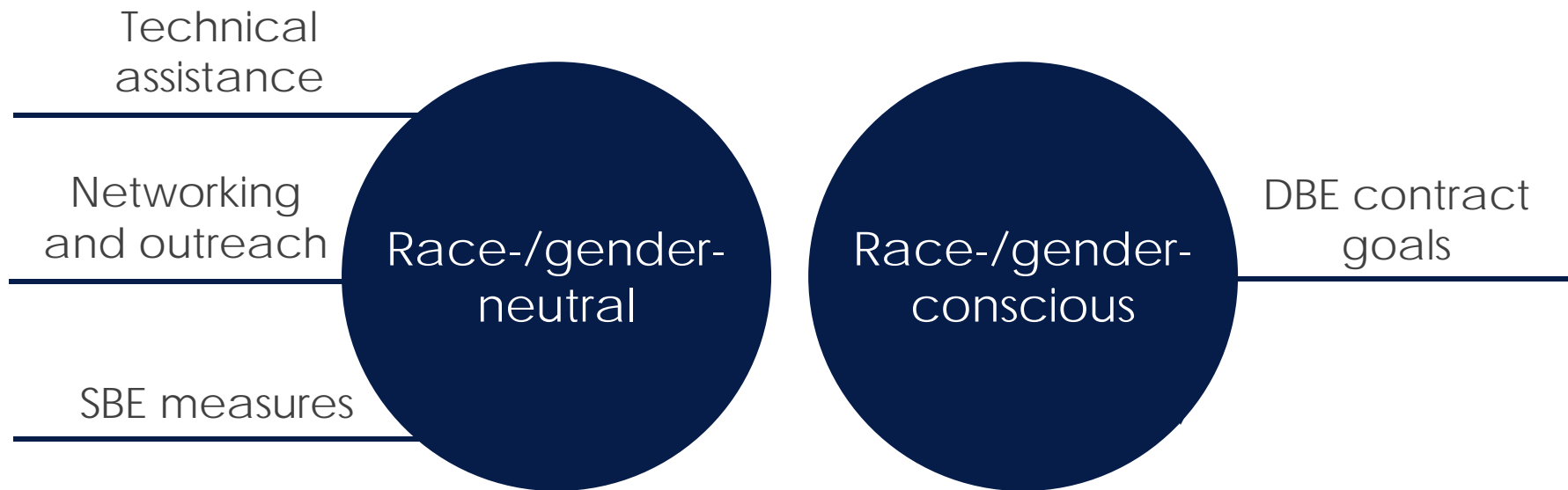
