



**TRANSPORTATION NOTICE
PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING
FOR
Nellis Boulevard Rehabilitation Project**



PURPOSE OF MEETING: The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT), in partnership with Clark County and the City of Las Vegas, invites you to a public information meeting to learn about the Nellis Boulevard Rehabilitation Project. This important road improvement project will address the roadway surface of Nellis Blvd. between Tropicana Ave. and Craig Rd. to provide a smoother and safer drive. Engineers are in the process of preliminary design with final design anticipated in Fall 2019. After design is complete, the project will progress to the construction phase. Construction may begin as early as Spring 2020. This meeting is designed to inform the traveling public, business owners and residents about the project. We will provide details related to the schedule and proposed roadway and safety improvements as well as possible sidewalk and driveway impacts. NDOT will solicit public feedback regarding the proposed improvements.

PROJECT BENEFITS: The goal of this project is to improve safety and connectivity for all road users:

- Replace the top few inches of the existing roadway pavement
- Improve pedestrian facilities including: reconstruction of sections of sidewalks, ADA ramps, driveways and more easily-accessible pedestrian push buttons at signalized intersections, to enhance pedestrian safety and mobility
- Improved transit accessibility by providing sidewalks and enhanced midblock pedestrian crossings
- Improved traffic operations by providing additional dedicated turn lanes and extension of Intelligent Transportation System facilities on Nellis Blvd. from Flamingo Rd. to Tropicana Ave.
- Replacing street lights fixtures with LEDs

WHEN AND WHERE: Tuesday, March 12, 2019, 4 to 7 p.m., **PRESENTATION AT 5:30 p.m.** Sam's Town Hotel/Casino, Hawthorne Room, 5111 Boulder Highway, Las Vegas, NV.

WHERE YOU COME IN: The meeting is designed to accommodate the public's schedule. Please attend at your convenience any time during the meeting hours of 4 to 7 p.m. Project representatives will be on hand to discuss and answer your questions and listen to your concerns. There will be a brief project presentation at 5:30 p.m., followed by a short question and answer period from the audience. Before and after the presentation, the meeting will be conducted as an open-house format to provide an opportunity to view displays and individually discuss the project with representatives. At the meeting, your comments may be submitted for public record in writing or verbally to a court reporter, who will be available throughout the meeting. A Spanish translator will be available during this meeting.
