SPAGHETTI BOWL PROJECT Preliminary Design Update

**I-80 from Sierra/Virginia/Center Interchange to Pyramid Hwy. Interchange
I-580/US 395 from N. McCarran/Clear Acre Interchange to Moana Ln.**

The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) will be sharing preliminary alternative designs for the Spaghetti Bowl in Northern Nevada. These designs will affect the future transportation flow of the Truckee Meadows region. The upgrade of the project area's freeway systems will reduce traffic congestion, increase traffic mobility, and is intended to increase safety.

We need your continued involvement. Please attend one of these meetings to ask questions and provide feedback about this proposed project.
